Acadiana YHEC Frogging Tournament Rules

- 1. Bullfrogs and pig frogs only.
- 2. All Participants must obey all Louisiana boating Safety Standards and Fish Regulations.
- 3. All Frogs submitted must comply with state restrictive guidelines. If the frog is registered/weighed and determined by the board to be in violation of restrictive guidelines, the frog will be disqualified.
- 4. <u>Tournament Prizes will consist of 50% of tickets sold.</u> Actual Prize is determined by amount of Participants. Max payout on each category will be \$1000.00. Remaining funds will be pooled for 2nd place in each category.
- 5. Contest begins at sundown on Friday, July 08, 2016 and ends at sunrise on Sunday, July 10, 2016
- 6. All participants must be registered no later than Sundown on Friday July 8, 2016. All registrants will receive a weigh in ticket. That ticket must be provided at weigh in. Each ticket is good for <u>one</u> weigh in only. Ex: If a boat captain weighs in on Saturday and chooses to frog Saturday night and weigh in again on the Sunday, that boat captain must purchase an additional weigh in ticket for \$50.00.
- 7. Fees apply to boat/captain only. There is no individual fees for helpers or riders
- 8. The geographical area for the tournament shall consist of all **public** waterways within the state of Louisiana , to keep the tournament fair to all participants, **private ponds/ leases and crawfish ponds are off limits**
- 9. All frogs must be alive and active for weigh in.
- 10. All Frogs are eligible for the heaviest frog and the 5 frog category.
- 11. Weights of frogs will be determined in pounds and ounces. In event of a tie, the result will be a split pot. No measurements will be used.
- 12. Frogs taken by devices other than hand catch are not eligible for competition.
- 13. NO one frog may be claimed by two participants/boats.
- 14. Please select the frog(s) you want weighed and entered before approaching scales.
- 15. Choose carefully, once frogs are weighed there will be no swap-outs to increase total weight.
- 16. All frogs weighed will be logged and returned to owner.
- 17. There will be two weigh ins.
 - *First Weigh* in will be held at Weeks Park in Lydia, on Saturday, July 9 between 10 am and 1 pm.
 - Second (final) Weigh in will be held at Weeks Park in Lydia Park on Sunday, July 10 between 10 am and 1 pm.
 - *<u>Tickets are valid for one weigh in only</u>. If weighing in on a Saturday and chose to participate again on the Sunday weigh in, a second ticket purchase will be required
- 18. Payout will follow final weigh in on Sunday, July 10, 2016 and will be to the registered boat captain. It will be at the discretion of the winning captain if/how winning is divided amongst team.
- 19. Any discrepancies must be addressed before leaving weigh in with frogs. Frogs will not be re-weighed after leaving scale area
- 20. Any person displaying poor unethical sportsmanship at any time during the tournament may be disqualified by an assigned Committee of Tournament Officials
- 21. Anyone disqualified for breaking any of the tournament rules or being part of any party trying to break any tournament rules will be barred from the tournament and are disqualified for all prizes and p.
- 22. THE DECISION OF THE TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS SHALL BE FINAL.
- 23. All persons registered in this tournament with the understanding that they have intentions of participating. No refund will be made on tickets /registrations.
- 24. ALL AWARDS NOT CLAIMED AT THE TOURNAMENT must be picked up by July 23, 2016 or be forfeited. Call Alex Verret at 337-577-5534 to claim prizes
- 25. All of the above rules are based on the honor system. Any complaints must be in written form, signed, and directed to the tournament committee within 15 minutes of the last frogs weighed.
- 26. Tournament scheduled rain or shine, if severe weather conditions prevail, the tournament committee shall decide within 24 hours of the tournament if it will take place or be postponed to another date.

It is expressly understood that all participants in the Acadiana YHEC Frogging Tournament enter at their own risk, and that the Acadiana Youth Hunter Education Club, Inc., Sponsors of the Acadiana Youth Hunter Education Club and all persons connected directly or indirectly with the operation of said tournament shall be exempt from any liability for libel, slander, loss, damage, negligence, harm, injury or death suffered by any participants which may occur during or in connection with the tournament
